GIVING HOPE MISSION PROJECT

We are excited to offer a summer long, hands-on mission project at Falls Creek Youth Camp. Send your students in the afternoons Wednesday through Friday to the amphitheater to take part in the Giving Hope Mission project with Oklahoma Baptists Disaster Relief. Giving Hope is made up of two projects. Messages of hope will allow students to write prayers and encouraging messages to be used as a part of a box and tape DR ministry. Students may also assemble First Contact bags that DR provides to families in crisis.
